

BORDER & VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

Ponta Do Ouro and Kosi Bay Border Information:

Border operating hours: 08H00 - 17H00 / 7 days a week. Tel: +27 (0)35 - 592 9181

Please ensure that you arrive at the border early, especially during high season when long queues can severely delay your estimated arrival time and cause you to miss the cut-off time for passing through the border.

You will need a valid passport with more than 6 months remaining until its expiry date. While citizens of South Africa, Botswana, Malawi, Mauritius, Swaziland, Tanzania, Zambia and Zimbabwe do not require holiday visas, all other nationalities require holiday visas to enter Mozambique. Visas can be obtained at the border post and may take approximately 30 minutes.

The driver will be required to present a valid driver's license (SA drivers' licenses are accepted). International and Mozambican driver's licenses are required when staying for longer than 6 months. These can be obtained from the AA.

If you are entering Mozambique with US\$ 5,000 or more, a "Declaration of entry of foreign currency" form must be collected and filled out at the customs desk.

VEHICLE & BOAT REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS

If your vehicle is currently being financed, you will need a letter from your bank allowing your vehicle to cross the border. A temporary import permit is compulsory for vehicles and can be filled out at the border (only the DA341 form). Temporary import permits are available at R 10.00 each.

A compulsory third party liability insurance certificate (valid for 30 days from date issued) will be required per vehicle and per towed application. Third party insurance (available at the border) is compulsory and costs R 150.00 per vehicle and R 80.00 per towed application.

If you are towing anything such as quad bikes, jet skis, a caravan or a trailer, you will need to attach the blue and yellow triangles to the front of your 4x4 and on the back of the towed application.

If your vehicle is longer than 6 meters, then you will be required to put reflectors on the front and rear of your vehicle. Each vehicle must have the required two red reflective triangles and two reflective vests.

VISITORS ARE ENTITLED TO IMPORT THE FOLLOWING:

Goods to the value of US\$ 200, inclusive of beer and other consumables, such as meat.

1 (one) litre of spirits / 2,5 litres (3 bottles) of wine / 2 cartons (or 400) cigarettes.

No drugs, firearms or explosive materials may be brought into Mozambique.
